Mother's Day Stall – Compass Opt-In Events

If you wish to opt-in and pay via Compass, please opt-in to your chosen spend event (\$5, \$10, \$15 or \$20) and make your payment at that time.

Due date is by end of the day this Wednesday 8th May.

Mother's Day Stall - Cash/Eftpos Payments

If you would like to pay cash for the Mother's Day stall, please come into the office and pay over the counter or put the cash in an envelope with your student(s) name(s) and room number(s) and dollar amount written on it and put it in the gold mailbox at the office.

If you would like to pay via eftpos, please come to the front desk and our friendly office staff can organise this for you. The names of the students and their spend allocation will be recorded on a sheet and these will be included with the voucher distribution list that I will generate from the Compass opt-in events.

The due date for cash and eftpos payments is by end of the day this Wednesday 8th May so that I have time to prepare the class lists and voucher allocation prior to the stall on Friday.

Mother's Day Stall – Friday 10th May

The stall will have gifts valued at \$5 and \$10 to make it easier for the students to calculate and use their vouchers. All vouchers equal \$5.00.

Vouchers will be handed to your students by their teachers on the Friday morning before going to the stall.

Students will be able to purchase 2 gifts during their classroom allocated time at the stall.

If they have any vouchers leftover, they can use them at lunchtime when all leftover gifts will be available for purchase.

Example: if you allocate a \$15 spend for your student, they will receive 3 x \$5 vouchers. During their class allocated time, they may choose to purchase 1 x \$10 gift and 1 x \$5 gift which means they have used all vouchers. If they choose to purchase 2 x \$5 gifts they will need to return to the stall at lunchtime and select a \$5 gift to use their remaining voucher.

Students in all classes will be reminded to use any remaining vouchers at the lunchtime stall prior to lunchtime.

Please remember to send your students to school with a bag so they can carry their specially picked gifts home!

Friday 10th May:

Our Mother's Day Stall will run a little differently this year. Instead of using a cash system we are going to use a voucher system. Each voucher is worth \$5.

Our stall will have gifts valued at \$5 or \$10 where students can buy a maximum of 2 gifts when their class attends the stall. All leftover gifts will be available at lunchtime for purchase.

On Monday we will send out 4 Compass Events:

- 1 event will be for a \$5 spend
- 1 event will be for a \$10 spend
- 1 event will be for a \$15 spend
- 1 event will be for a \$20 spend

Please decide how much you would like your student to spend and only opt-in and pay for that event. Vouchers will be given to your student on the day of the stall. *Please keep in mind there will be no refunds issued for unspent vouchers.*
